

**Unitarian Universalist Metro Atlanta North
Adult Programs Facilitator Policy**

Mission Statement and Goals of the Adult Enrichment Committee:

To provide transformative learning and growth experiences that enrich our lives and deepen our understanding of what it means to be a Unitarian Universalist.

Adult Programs Facilitator Criteria:

It is a policy of the Adult Enrichment Committee that a facilitator of an adult class must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a member or friend of the Unitarian Universalist Metro Atlanta North for at least six months.
2. Demonstrate appropriate leadership experience, or get necessary experience either by co-facilitating an adult faith development class with an experienced facilitator or by attending a facilitator training class.
3. Complete “Course Proposal Form”, which will be reviewed by the Adult Enrichment Committee in consultation with the minister.

We consider these criteria in choosing facilitators:

- Knowledge of Unitarian Universalism
- Involvement in the congregation
- Trust within the congregation
- Effectiveness at speaking, teaching, and facilitating
- Listening skills
- Whether the facilitator is responsible and respectful, with strong interpersonal boundaries
- Degree of organization and competence.
