





Process Overview

- July 2019 Board sets goal to hire Interim Director of Religious Eduction (IDRE) by early 2020
- August 2019 Consultation with Michelle Grove, Guild of Interim Religious Educators
- September 2019 IDRE Search Committee Formed
 - Bob Popp, chair
 - Jacqueline Gore
 - Margriet van de Steeg
 - Steven Seaver
- October 2019 Job Description posted on UUA/LREDA/UUMAN websites

Why an Interim?

- UUA recommends in situations like ours
- Normal DRE Responsibilities
 - Planning and implementing UUMAN's children and youth religious education programs.
 - Recruiting, motivating, training, supporting and managing RE Volunteers.
 - Overseeing administrative functions of UUMAN's religious education programs.
 - Fostering a supportive, engaged, and joyful religious education environment for the UUMAN congregation.
- Interim Extra Responsibilities
 - Coming to terms with the religious program history.
 - Developing a renewed UUMAN religious education program Identity.
 - Reviewing and renewing UUA local and regional connections.
 - Committing to the future of the religious education program's vitality

Interim DRE Position

- Spring 2020 to July 2021
- ▶ ¾ time position
- Salary based on experience and UUA guidelines
- ▶ IDRE reports to the minister
- Interim not eligible for permanent position
- Status
 - 2 candidates so far
 - ▶ 1 interview held, 1 interview scheduled


