### **Board Vice-President Nominee**



# How Are We Doing Financially?

### Overall

- Okay but we could be doing better!
- End of year projection running a cash flow deficit!
- Cash flow has been steady and consistent
- Paid all our bills on time
- Paid down our mortgage by ~\$21,000
- Funded an infrastructure depreciation fund!

# FY2017-2018 Operating Income

- Total Income Projection: \$304K
  - Exceeded our budget by ~\$4,800
- Pledges: Budget \$237K → Projecting \$236K
- Rentals: on Target @ \$31,000
- Fundraisers: will exceed our target
  - Goal of \$19,200 → Actual of \$23,000
- Plate: will exceed our target by \$3,600

# FY2017-2018 Operating Expenses

- Expense Budget: \$272K
- Expense Projection: \$284K
- Expense Variance: \$12K
  - Operations: (\$3,000)
  - MCY: (\$1,700)
  - Worship: (\$4,300)
  - Finance/Admin/Board: (\$4,900)

### FY2017-2018 Net Income/Cash Flow

- Net Income Projection: \$20,000
  - Mortgage Principle: \$21,000
  - Infrastructure Depr: \$8,000
  - Minister Sabbatical: \$1,000
- Cash Flow Projection: -\$10,000

# Other Funding Sources


- There Campaign: January 2017 to June 2018
  - "for repairs and improvements to our campus, and ....a much needed reserve fund"
  - \$19,770 original financial commitments
  - \$17,965 received to date! \$1,800 left to collect by June 30.
  - \$1,043 remaining in the account
  - How we used the money:
    - Refurbish Fellowship Hall, Repair Sanctuary Ceiling, Refinish Sanctuary and Foyer Floors, Purchased FH Furniture
- Life Gifting & Moravian Pies
  - "for capital improvement projects"
  - ~\$1,200 collected so far this year
  - \$3,541 in the account



# FY2018-2019 Operating Income






Current Year \$304,250

# FY18-19 Expense Budget Changes

- Membership same budget as this year minus canvas costs which were moved to a new Stewardship category
- Operations: some challenges here. Will need to be closely monitored.
  - Board/Bldg Insurance Expense: Set to actual for this year as are Church Mutual costs went up this year to \$527/month.
  - Cleaning: set at \$7,000. This is below what was spent this year however
  - Landscaping/Outdoor Maint: Set at \$500 close to what we spent this year however not enough to pay for tree work that needs to be done next year.
  - Electric: Set at \$9,500 as our budgeted billing by GPC went up to \$788/month earlier this year.
  - Infrastructure Depreciation: Set at \$4,000 which is 1/4 of our expected futures replacement, maintenance and repair costs.

# FY18-19 Expense Budget Changes

- MCY: same budget as last year with the following changes.
  - MCY Director salary: Cost of living increase
  - MCY Premo setup: Completely removed from the budget. The Board is committed to finding a way to do this with volunteers.
  - Nursery Staff: Reduced to \$4,500 however Nursery staff compensation increased.
  - Volunteer Dev.: Reduced to \$250 although.
- Worship: same budget as last year with the following changes.
  - Minister professional expenses: Set at \$4,000, \$1,000 increase over this year's budget.
  - Music Director: Added 1 hour more a week in compensation.
  - Music supplies: Set at \$250, 1/2 of this year
  - Worship other: Set at \$500, \$350 below this year

# FY18-19 Expense Budget Changes

- Finance/Admin/Board
  - Office expense: Set at \$2,000, \$1,000 over this years budget.
  - Board expense: Set at \$600.
  - FICA: Increased to \$5,600.
  - Workers Comp: Increased to \$1,500.
  - Office Admin compensation: Increased to \$16,500.
- Young Adult \$100
- Earth Ministry \$200
- Leadership Development \$400
- Hospitality \$200
- Stewardship \$300
- Endowment \$300
